- a. **FELIX RULE** [™]: A rule used for measuring Amplitude of accommodation and Near point of Convergence. This invention is currently in use among optometrists in Nigeria. It is currently awaiting patency.
- b. FELIUSTIN ™: A Volk lens adapter for slitlamp. This is widely used by optometrists in Nigeria. It is also currently awaiting patency
- c. **FELISCOPE** [™]: A vergence stereoscope for accommodation and vergence training in Vision therapy.
- d. **FELIDAPTER** ™: (An Android Phone adapter for slitlamp photography and videography).
- e. **FELIX VD RULE** ™: A vertex distance rule
- f. **FELIX NBVT** [™]: A near binocular vision tester that can assist optometrist perform over 18 binocular vision tests at near.
- g. **FELITER™**: A slitlamp yellow filter accessory
- h. **FELITONY™**: A Schematic eye for Ophthalmoscopy

- Through FOM, he has helped the Nigerian Optometric Association (NOA) to raise optometrists' confidence in clinical optometric practice and he has been able to bridge the hitherto existing wide knowledge gap between senior and junior optometrists.
